What is Safer Homes South Derbyshire?

A free service working to improve security in the homes of older (aged 60+) and vulnerable people who live in South Derbyshire.

The scheme works by installing security equipment free of charge, including door chains, window alarms and spy holes.

In addition, the Safer Homes operative will give free crime prevention advice.



Who can make referrals?

You can refer yourself to the scheme, and we also take referrals from other agencies such as Derbyshire County Council Adult Care, South Derbyshire District Council, Derbyshire Police, Health Professionals, Housing Associations, Citizens Advice Bureau, South Derbyshire CVS.

How are referrals made?

To refer yourself or one of your clients, complete the referral form opposite and return it to the address on the back of this leaflet. You will then be contacted to discuss requirements and book an appointment.


How much does it cost?

The service is free.
